Student Services Board Policies Question: What do you mean when you say "required" board policy? Our list of legally required SS policies is the list that is required by state or federal law. Other potentially required policies: Program specific – i.e. independent study, only necessary if you offer independent study of any kind. Grade level specific – i.e. math placement policy, only necessary for schools with a 9th grade. MOU/Charter specific policies - you may have agreed within your charter or an MOU with your authorizer to additional policies beyond what is included in law.
